While uncertainty is high, **COVID-19 burden was likely growing throughout early June** across the state.

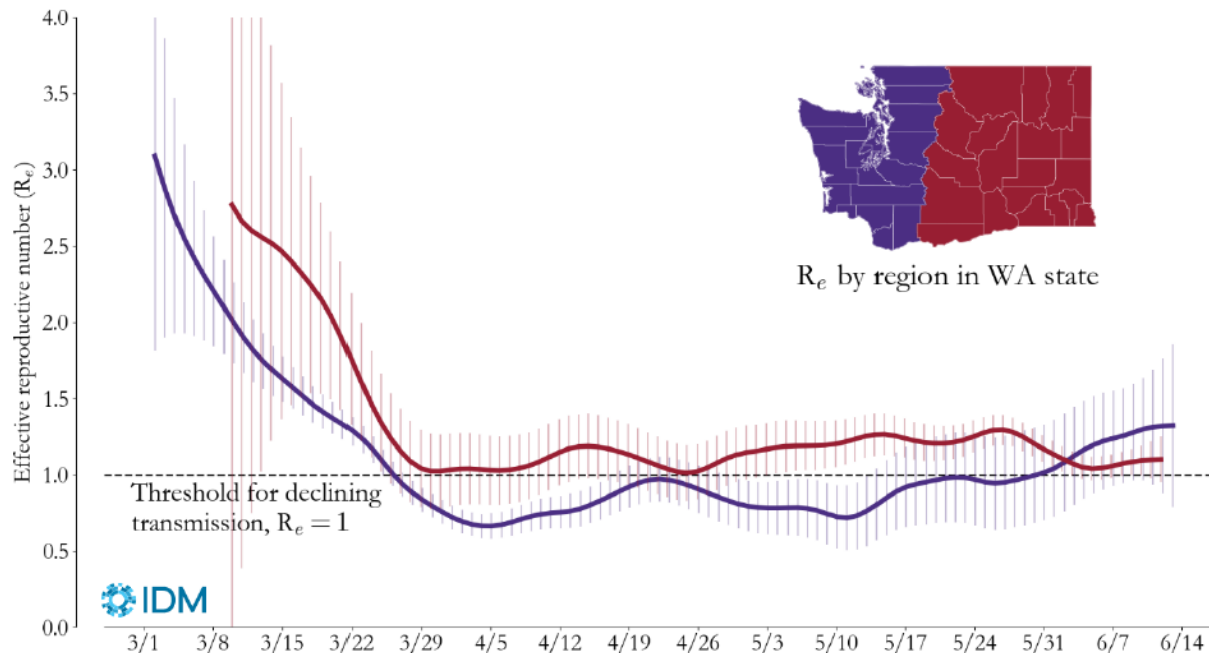


Figure: "Situation Report 6: COVID-19 transmission across Washington State." Available soon at covid.idmod.org.

Our best estimates of the effective reproductive number are above 1 in both regions.

- Mandatory masks policy was timely, continued monitoring may shed light on the effects.
- This model can't determine causes: reopening, protests against police violence, etc. are all confounded.

Distribution Milestones

- Distribution Push 1 (initial push to major hospitals)- 5/14/20
 - 800 Vials to 11 hospitals
- Distribution Push 2 (focus on hospital systems)- 5/22 - 6/11/20
 - 280 vials to 5 hospital systems
 - 754 vials to 9 hospital systems
 - 440 vials to 6 hospital systems
 - 6 vials to 1 hospital
 - 180 vials to 1 hospital system
- Distribution Push 3 (prepositioning in some mid-size hospitals)- June 9 to June 11
 - 110 vials to 6 hospitals
- Requests- Currently ongoing
 - 1438 vials to 13 hospitals and hospital systems

Requests Fulfilled

- Since we began approving requests as they are received from hospitals, this is the distribution pattern:
 - Week of 6/8: 120 for Prosser Memorial and Astria
 - Week of 6/15: 374 vials for Confluence, PeaceHealth, Legacy Salmon Creek, Virginia Mason Memorial, Jefferson Healthcare, Trios and Lourdes Health, Mid-Valley
 - Week of 6/22: 929 vials for Providence, Astria, Confluence, Samaritan Healthcare, CHI, Virginia Mason

Next Steps

- DHHS allocating last donated doses to states this week
- New DHHS and Gilead agreement:
 - DHHS will secure >500,000 treatment courses of remdesivir for hospitals through September
 - DHHS will allow hospitals to purchase the drug in amounts allocated by HHS/DOH (~\$3,200 per course) starting the week of July 13
 - DHHS will deliver purchased remdesivir directly to hospital, per the state's allocation decision,
 - DHHS and states will continue to manage allocation to hospitals until the end of September
- After September, once supplies are less constrained, HHS will no longer manage allocation

Remdesivir Pricing

- Governments of developed countries
 - \$390 per vial
 - \$2,340 per patient for 5-day treatment course
- U.S. private insurance companies
 - \$520 per vial
 - \$3120 per patient for 5-day treatment course
