



What happens if I don't choose a health care agent?

Washington State law lists who will make health care decisions for you if you cannot

The order for who will decide is:

A guardian appointed by a court



Named **health care agent** in the durable power of attorney for health care (DPOA-HC) advance directive



Your **spouse** or **registered domestic partner** (even if separated)



Your **adult children** *



Your **parents** *



Your **adult siblings** *



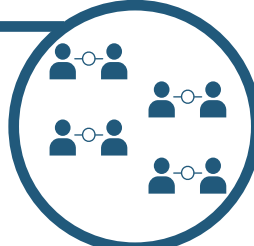
Your **adult grandchildren** *



Your **adult nieces & nephews** *



Your **adult aunts & uncles** *



A **close friend** who meets certain criteria



***Any group that has more than one person: all in the group must agree to the care**
