Monroe, Wash. - EvergreenHealth Monroe recently received recognition from the Healthcare Information and Management Systems Society (HIMSS) for reaching stage 6 on the HIMSS Electronic Medical Record Adoption Model (EMRAM). EvergreenHealth Monroe joins EvergreenHealth Medical Center in Kirkland in reaching this distinction level. The two are among just [23 health care facilities](#) out of the nearly 120 hospitals across Washington state to reach this achievement. This designation also places the Monroe-based hospital among the top 29 percent of hospitals within the HIMSS Analytics system across the country.

EvergreenHealth Monroe received the recognition for nearing full automation of medical record access across inpatient care settings and enabling medical staff to effectively utilize information technology to improve patient safety. Hospitals achieving this honor hold distinctive advantages in patient safety, clinician support, and clinician recruitment.
