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# Objectives

1. Review all MBQIP measures due in fourth quarter.
2. Identify and understand new measures for the fourth quarter.

Fourth Quarter, 2015 Measures - Inpatient and Outpatient		Dropped Qtr. 4
Inpatient	IMM-2: Influenza Immunization	PN-6b: Initial ABX selection for CAP  HF-2: Evaluation of LVS function

This measure is used to assess the time (in minutes) from emergency department (ED) arrival to provider contact for ED patients.

Description: Average time patient's spent in the emergency department before they were seen by a healthcare professional (Physician/APN/PA).

Populations: All

Denominator Inclusions/Exclusions:

- **Inclusions** - Any emergency department (ED) patient from the facility's ED
- **Exclusions** - Patients who expired in the ED

Numerator Inclusions/Exclusions:

- **Inclusions** - Time (in minutes) from emergency department (ED) arrival to provider contact for patients discharged from the ED
- **Exclusions** - None

This measure is used to assess the time (in minutes) from emergency department (ED) arrival to time of initial oral or parenteral pain medication administration for ED patients with a principal diagnosis of long bone fracture.

Description: Average time patients who came to the emergency department with broken bones had to wait before receiving pain medications.

Populations: Ages greater than or equal to 2 years old on encounter day

Denominator:

- Inclusions - *Principal Diagnosis Code* for a (long bone) fracture, and Patients with *Pain Medication* (as defined in the Data Dictionary).
- Exclusions - Patients less than 2 years of age, Patients who expired, and Patients who left the ED against medical advice or discontinued care

Numerator:

- Inclusions - *Continuous variable statement:* Time (in minutes) from emergency department (ED) arrival to time of initial oral or parenteral pain medication administration for ED patients with a diagnosis of a (long bone) fracture
- Exclusions -None

Percent of patients leaving without being seen by a qualified medical personnel.

Numerator: Number of patients leaving without being seen (LWBS) by a qualified medical personnel.

Denominator: Sum of all patients presenting to the emergency department

Description: Healthcare workers given influenza vaccination

Denominator: Healthcare personnel (HCP) who are physically present in the healthcare facility for at least 1 working day between October 1 and March 31 of the following year.

Denominators are to be calculated separately for three required categories of HCP:

- a) Employees (not full time equivalents): Includes all persons who receive a direct paycheck from the reporting facility (on the payroll), regardless of clinical responsibility or patient contact.
- b) Licensed independent practitioners (LIPs): Includes physicians, advanced practice nurses, and physicians assistant only who are affiliated with the reporting facility, but not directly employed by it, regardless of clinical responsibility or patient contact.
- c) Adult students/trainees and volunteers: Includes medical, nursing, or other health professional students, interns, medical residents, r volunteers aged 18 or older who are affiliated with the healthcare facility, but are not directly employed by it.



Numerator/Exclusions: Healthcare personnel (HCP) in the denominator population, who during the time from when the vaccine became available (e.g., August or September) through March 31 of the following year:

- a) received an influenza vaccination administered at the healthcare facility; or
- b) reported in writing (paper or electronic); or provided documentation that influenza vaccination was received elsewhere; or
- c) were determined to have a medical contraindication/condition of severe allergic reaction to eggs or to other component(s) of the vaccine, or history of Guillain-Barré syndrome within 6 weeks after a previous influenza vaccination; or
- d) Were offered but declined influenza vaccination
- e) Have an unknown vaccination status or did not otherwise meet any of the definitions of the above-mentioned numerator





Categories for declined vaccination include:

1. Persons who decline vaccination because of conditions other than those specified in c) on the previous slide.
2. Persons who decline vaccination and did not provide any other information.
3. Persons who did not receive vaccination because of religious or philosophical exemptions.
4. Persons who deferred vaccination all season.

Description: This prevention measure addresses acute care hospitalized inpatients age 6 months and older who were screened for seasonal influenza immunization status and were vaccinated prior to discharge if indicated.

Populations: Inpatient discharges 6 months of age and older

Denominator: Acute care hospitalized inpatients age 6 months and older discharged during October, November, December, January, February or March.

Numerator: Inpatient discharges who were screened for influenza vaccine status and were vaccinated prior to discharge if indicated.

## Cells for data entry

- **Reporting Period:** click in the cell and type in the reporting period
- **Hospital Name:** click in the cell and type hospital name
- **Denominator:** enter the number of records reviewed; this number should not exceed 45 for any quarter
- **Numerators:** enter the numerators for the EDTC 1-7 sub-measures as well as the All EDTC measure

## Reporting the All EDTC Measure

The All EDTC measure is not a summation of EDTC 1-7. The All EDTC numerator is a number calculated in the [reporting tool](#) (under “ED Transfer Communication Resources”) that counts how many cases met ALL communication criteria, so this number will not be larger than the lowest numerator found in EDTC 1-7, and will most likely be even lower (see the examples below). This is not a numerator that can be calculated by hand; it must be generated by the reporting tool. Please be sure to use the [tool](#) so it generates this numerator.

- Once you have completed data entry, please save the file using the following naming convention: Hospital name, EDTC, and the reporting quarter. **For example, JeffersonEDTC1Q15.**
