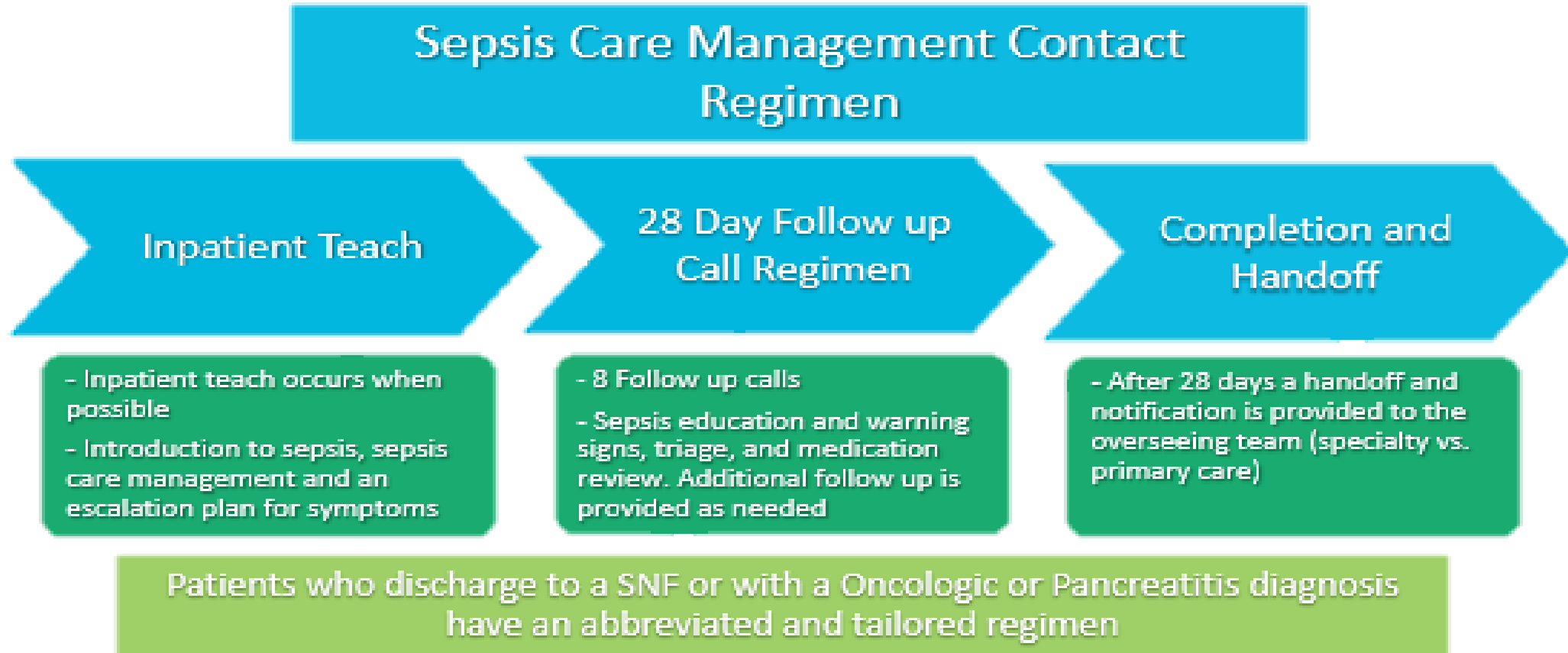
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Patient Selection Criteria

- Patients appropriate for sepsis intensive care management meet the selection criteria below:
 - SIRS +
 - Lactate >2 for >24 hrs
 - Organ Dysfunction
 - Vent/Pressors
 - Comorbidities (CHF, COPD DM...)
 - Social Determinant Needs
 - Recent Sepsis Admissions

- Identification and tracking of patients managed through Vigilanz and Cerner

- **Program Initiation - April 2019. Data, as of March 31, 2020:**
 - 219 total patients
 - 2479 total touches: Including phone calls, Cerner messages, care coordination, and review for Sepsis Intensive Care Management appropriateness
