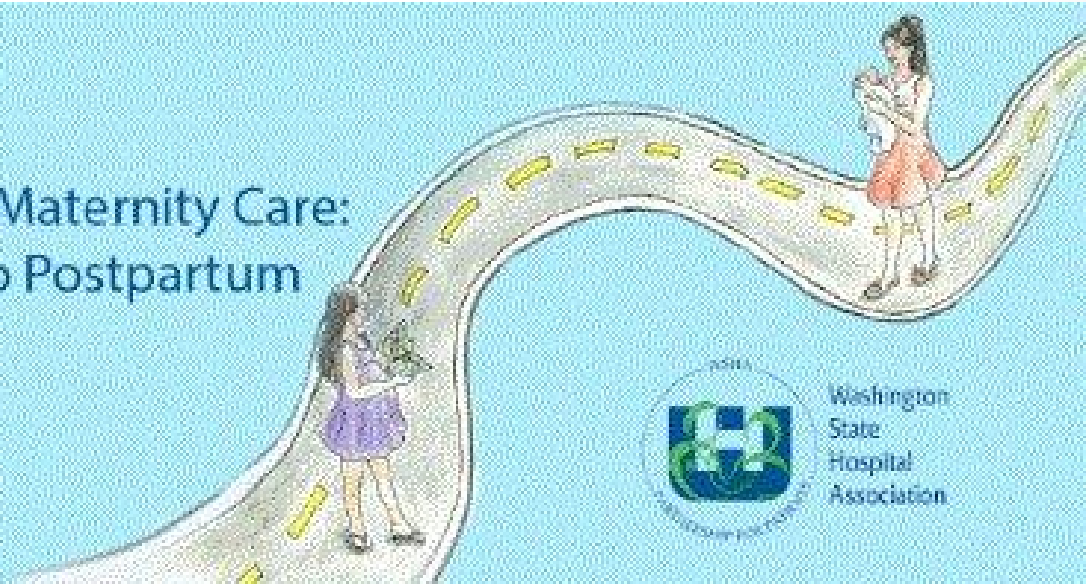

10 Strategies - 65

STRATEGIES

EED
Episiotomy
Hemorrhage
Pre-eclampsia

MEASURES

*Percent early elective deliveries (PC-01)

*Episiotomy rate for spontaneous vaginal delivery (without shoulder dystocia or forceps or vacuum)

*Hemorrhage:
- Percent women transfused
- Number of blood units transfused
- Total number of massive blood transfusions (>4 units)

*Preeclampsia:
- Percent with severe preeclampsia who received timely treatment within 60 minutes
- For those with preeclampsia diagnosis, number of maternal ICU admissions and number of ICU days

* Reported to CMS

Roadmap (Labor Management) - 50

STRATEGIES

Labor Management Bundles

OUTCOME MEASURES

NTSV cesarean section (nulliparous, term, singleton, vertex)
TSV primary cesarean section (term, singleton, vertex)
Elective induction of labor
Maternal admission to intensive care unit
Maternal transfusion
Maternal length of stay
Operative vaginal delivery
Unexpected newborn complications

Labor Management Bundles

MEASURES

All roadmap outcomes measures
*Percent elective induction with unfavorable cervix (no cervical ripening)
*Percent completed checklists
Process measures: limited data set

PROCESS MEASURES

Percent completed induction bundle checklist
Percent compliance completed first stage labor bundle checklist
Percent completed second stage labor bundle checklist



Partnership for Patients

- 40 – Percent reduction in harm
- 20 – Percent reduction in readmissions
- 14 – by 2014

Saving Lives



10 Targeted Strategies

Infection Reduction:

1. Catheter-associated urinary tract infections (CAUTI)
2. Central line-associated blood stream infections (CLABSI)
3. Surgical site infections (SSI)
4. Ventilator-associated pneumonia (VAP)

Nursing Care:

5. Injuries from falls and immobility
6. Pressure ulcers

High Risk:

7. Adverse drug events
8. **Obstetrical adverse events**
9. Venous thromboembolism or blood clots (VTE)

Continuity of Care:

10. Prevention of readmissions

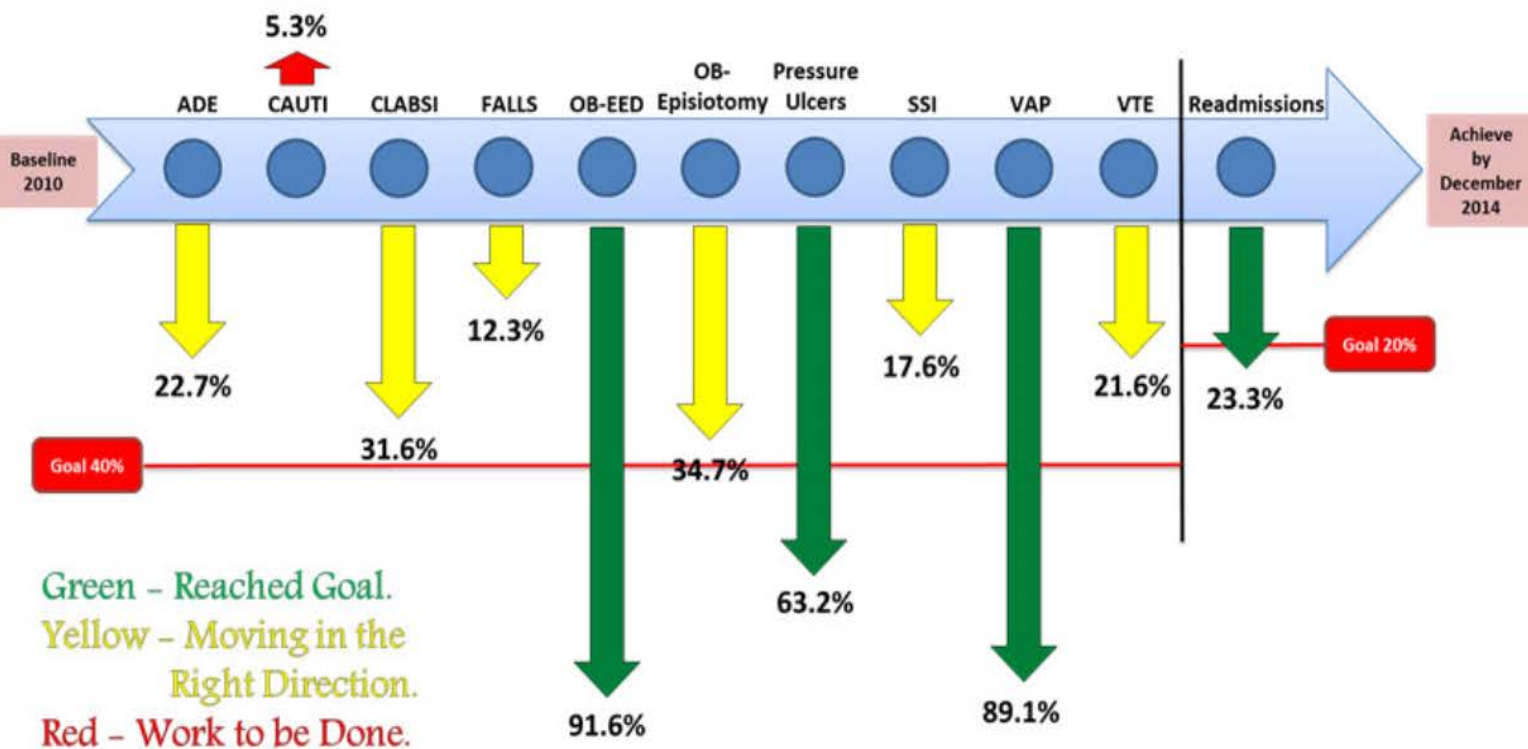

Harm and Readmissions Reduction Results

Below the Line is Better



Submission Rates for Most Recent Quarter:

CLABSI:	98.4%
VAP:	89.4%
CAUTI:	98.4%
SSI:	90.0%
Falls:	88.9%

Pressure Ulcers:

Pressure Ulcers:	86.0%
OB-EED:	88.7%
VTE:	82.7%

Readmission:

Readmission:	100.0%
ADE:	52.7%
Leadership, Patient and Family:	86.0%

Partnership for Patients

Preeclampsia measures:

- Number of maternal ICU admissions/delivering women >20 weeks gestation with diagnosis of preeclampsia.
- Number of maternal ICU days/100 delivering women \geq 20 weeks gestation with diagnosis of preeclampsia.
- Percent hospitalized women with severe preeclampsia who received timely treatment within 60 minutes.
